

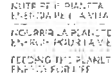

The Comitato Italiano Fotogrammetria Architettonica (COIFA - <http://coifa.it>) is pleased to announce the organization of the VI International Summer School "Survey for Planning: New Technologies and Land Protection" (ISS 2015 - <http://coifa.it/iss2015/>), under the patronage of the Comune di Alberobello, Commission 3 of International Federation of Surveyors (FIG), Cattedra Fisica Tecnica of Politecnico Bari, Comitato Regionale Geometri e Geometri Laureati of Puglia, Cattedra Storia Arte Moderna of University Bari and Collegio Geometri e Geometri Laureati of Matera.

The course, arranged by the Comitato Italiano Fotogrammetria Architettonica in cooperation with
Comune di Castellana Grotte (Bari), "*Porta della Valle d'Itria*"
Comune di Serracapriola (Foggia), example "*GIS pilota*"
Comune di Locorotondo (Bari), "*Cuore della Valle d'Itria*"
Comune di Laterza (Taranto), "*Terra delle Gravine*"
Comune di Noci (Bari),
Grotte di Castellana,
will take place in Alberobello and Matera from 12th to 23th July 2015 (with check-in on 12th and check-out on 23th).

The work of the ISS in 2015 will be open July 12, 2015 at the EXPO 2015 in Milan.

The opening session of the work of the sixth edition of the International Summer School will illustrate the importance and the change of "representation of the Environment" and then the "change of mentality" for the knowledge and preservation of the same Environment: Environment understood as "body living" and therefore always changing. It will highlight the problems of the route not yet finalized, the transition from paper to digital starting from the "historical maps," crossing the "GIS (Global Information System)" up to the "DSS (Decision Support System)."

The work of the VI International Summer School will be presented at the Council Chamber of the City of Alberobello July 23, 2015. During this event, the participants will receive their certificate of attendance in the Course. It is noted, too, that the work of the VI International Summer School will be on display in EXPO 2015

The VI International Summer School is open to both European Young Surveyors and Young Surveyors coming from Extra-European Countries (Mediterranean Area, Asia,

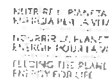

Russia, America and other) up to 35 years old and will be held in English language. The teachers involved in this event will be from Italy and from several European Countries.

In order to take part in the VI International Summer School all participants have to satisfy the following:

- Age up to 35 years old;
- Good knowledge of English language;
- Expertise in the field of survey;
- Not present in the previous courses;
- good knowledge of the major social networks and Skype;
- Moral and psycho-physical requirements that are valid to work in the Public Administration and to practise the free profession.

Both the Comitato Italiano Fotogrammetria Architettura and the other organizers will take charge of every expenses of all participants related to their permanence during the course except the travels ones to Milan (arrival) and from Bari (departure). The only expense that participants have to bear is the insurance fee for any medical costs and disruption of the instruments used: the insurance fee is approximately € 190.00 (approximately one hundred and ninety euro) to be paid in Milan, July 12, 2015, before the opening session of the ISS in 2015.

So dear Colleagues, I warmly invite You to send 2 representatives (different from the previous ones) of Your Country to participate in the Course. Considering that the number of participants will be limited to 50 (36 internationals and 14 italians), for the admission we will follow the chronological order of arrival of demands and the analysis of the CV.
